Parish Share 2025

Each year, the Diocesan Synod agrees on a budget for the expenditure from the Diocesan Common Fund. The principal part of Diocesan Common Fund expenditure relates to the cost of providing clergy to minister in our parishes, their stipends and related costs, and their housing and training, both pre- and post-ordination. Money is also required to fund the work of the wider Church in our diocese, in providing support services and resources for parish ministries, including grants for parishes that are struggling, and also a contribution towards the costs of the National Church.
